CONTEST DETAILS AND RULES

1. All entrants must be a registered Salem County High School student from one of the following schools:

Woodstown High School
Pennsville High School

Pennsgrove High School
Salem High School

Arthur P. Schalick High School
Salem Cty Career & Tech High School

2. All entries must be submitted on the canvas provided by Franklin Bank.

3. All entries must be submitted to Franklin Bank by **April 10, 2026** no later than 5:00 pm.

4. The mural is intended to celebrate Franklin Bank's 165th anniversary in business! The following elements must be included in the sketch:

- An image of Benjamin Franklin
- A representation of banking through the ages
- Notation of our 165th anniversary April 18, 1861 - April 18, 2026



5. Submissions must be the **artist's original work**.

6. Computer or Artificial Intelligence generated images are not acceptable.

7. Sketches will be displayed during the Salem County Film and Arts Festival in Woodstown on Saturday, April 25, 2026

8. Sketches will be displayed from Monday, April 27, 2026 until Saturday, May 9, 2026 at Franklin Bank's Pilesgrove Office.

9. Voting will be conducted electronically via a QR code to be displayed at the Salem County Film and Arts Festival and at Franklin Bank's Pilesgrove Office.

10. Anyone can vote. Only one entry per person is allowed.

11. Votes will be **counted and verified** by Franklin Bank. The winner will be the sketch with the most votes. The decision will be final.

12. The winner will be provided with all necessary art materials to complete the mural i.e. paint, brushes, drop cloths etc.

13. Franklin Bank is flexible with the completion time of the mural and will work with the winner around their school schedule.

14. The **\$1,000 commission fee** will be paid via check during a **Mural Revealing Ceremony** to be held no later than 30 days after the completion of the mural.

15. Winner agrees to have their picture taken and published on the bank's social media platforms and any other media outlet that the bank approves.

16. Since the mural is on Franklin Bank property, Franklin Bank reserves the right to determine how long the mural will remain.

17. Franklin Bank reserves the right to reproduce and distribute the mural in physical or digital form for marketing purposes.
